A letter from your Board President

Suddenly, it's summer!

We have come through another winter and the community is looking well. The grass is green, trees and shrubs are blooming. It is great to be outdoors and enjoying time and activities with our families.

Monsoon season is fast approaching. Be aware of blowing debris and secure items that could be displaced and areas that may flood.

The two Little Free Libraries are flourishing – thank you to everyone who "takes a book and leaves a book"! Quite an assortment of reading materials for all age groups, and many are in Spanish.

One troubling item is the vandalism at the Fairy Duster Park, where the Sit 'n Spin has once again been damaged. At a replacement cost of nearly \$1,000.00, this is a very serious issue, not only in the financial aspect (which affects your dues) but also as a safety hazard for our children. This is actually the 3rd Sit 'n Spin that has been destroyed, so that is \$3,000 which could have been used for maintenance.

The Board has agreed to one more replacement, but that will be the last time. If the Sit 'n Spin is broken or destroyed again, it will not be replaced. That also applies to any other playground equipment. Once gone, it is gone forever. We cannot keep replacing equipment due to the

vagaries and bad decisions of some.

Another issue is the recent destruction of the grass at Fairy Duster and Parsnip.

The cost to correct this mischief is being determined, but this is another example of the financial impact to the community.



Our community should be a safe haven for everyone, young and old, to enjoy.
